NOTES ON THE WINE

This Pinot Noir is surprisingly smooth with a dark rich color and welcome collection of flavors. On the nose you will be greeted with the lightly floral aromas, along with the notes of ripe cherries and strawberries. These fruit components follow through to the flavor, delivering a smooth mouth-feel with layers of rich fruit flavors, red licorice and a touch of spice. Approachable and instantly enjoyable, you'll find this Pinot Noir to be an interesting addition to your personal wine list.
