NOTES ON THE WINE

This White Zinfandel has an alluring coral-pink hue. On the nose are aromas of strawberries and cherries. Tasting delivers flavors of strawberry jam, fresh flowers and tropical fruit. A balance of fruit sweetness and acidity give this wine a fresh clean mouth-feel and a mildly sweet, crisp finish.
