NOTES ON THE WINE

This Merlot has a deep, rich ruby color. Layered aromas of boysenberry and black plum are accented with notes of cocoa nib, black licorice, coffee and a suggestion of soy. Round, smooth tannins in this juicy, approachable Merlot complement flavors of blackberry and toast before a lingering finish.
