NOTES ON THE WINE

Our Riesling is delicate, yet full of fruit-forward flavors. There are aromas of dried fruit, lemon, lavender, jasmine and rose petal. In the mouth, the crisp acidity balances this well-structured wine with flavors of peach, pineapple and pear that lead to a smooth, lingering finish.
